

At 4.1m long and weighing over 100kg, this is the world's largest crochet sea turtle made entirely out of recycled plastic from domestic and industrial waste. Titled 'Remnant', it has taken artist Annie Hsiao-Wen Wang 2 years to complete; and began life whilst she and her husband Mark were living in Thailand, witnessing firsthand the destruction of our oceans through plastic pollution.

'Poly', together with *One Brown Planet* (an environmental initiative founded by Mark), is now touring around Taiwan, educating the public about the detrimental effects of single-use plastics.

台灣出生 澳洲長大的藝術家 王筱雯 Annie以 長達兩年時間, 收集工廠廢棄的塑膠帶編織了一隻4.1米、100公斤的大海龜Poly。這個計劃是從2014年時Annie和先生Mark搬到泰國開始。 那時他們住在沙灘上, 痛心美麗的海灘卻有著大量的塑料污染, 啓發了Annie決定以創作分享環保意識為起點。

這件裝置藝術作品,『Remnant 遺留』,是 為海洋也為海洋裡所有動物的呼喊。Mark也設立了環保議題的網站One Brown Planet,希望能夠透過這計劃,喚醒大家環保意識,讓海洋回歸平衡。
